**Course:     Advanced EAP Speech (1560)**

**Objective :** Students will become acquainted with the concept of and imperative for green architecture including codes/ laws that consider the health and vitality of the land, learn vocabulary related to the field, discuss cultural attitudes, and research and describe green architecture projects in the US and other countries.

**1. Students will be provided with an introduction to the concept of green architecture as well as a list of vocabulary and terms associated with the field.**

**2. Students will be shown photographs of selected famous green architecture projects, primarily in Germany and the US. The instructor will describe the features of these projects, explain how they contribute to sustainability and reduce negative environmental impact. The instructor will also engage students in discussions about cultural attitudes toward environmental responsibility.**

**3. Students will conduct research on other existing green architecture projects around the world as well as in their native countries and present their findings in an oral presentation for the instructor's evaluation of their research, presentation and language skills, and grasp of the imperative for "greener" dwellings, manufacturing facilities, and office structures.**
