Who: Fundamentals of Speech, SPC 1026

What: A student driven survey to determine student's perceptions of the college's (North Campus) environmental awareness and efforts toward sustainability.

When: 3 year on going project each major term, 2009-2011

Why: To determine the level of perception that students hold regarding the college's commitment to sustainability issues.

1. Value to institution: This would measure the level of student understanding regarding the college's commitment to environmental sustainability.

2. Value to student: This would give students the opportunity to practice outcome #1 and outcome #2.

How: In 2008-2, I will work with Speech students to develop a survey that will be used to measure the perceptions of the student population each semester. I will request assistance from Institutional Research in order to establish a partnership creating a survey that is appropriate and measurable. Involved Students each semester will be assigned a certain number of students to interview throughout the North Campus for the purpose of determining overall student perceptions. The Speech students who conduct the survey will qualify for service learning hours. The title of the Service Learning project will be determined by the students who develop the survey.
