Objectives:

Strategies:

- Students will use the internet to research the Native Americans - they will use browsers and search engines to limit their focus.
- They will gather information and pictures:
 - on regions
 - lifestyle
 - coexistence with regional plants and animals
- The URL's must be saved as references.
- Their course of design templates will need to reflect the subject.
- The information(in their own words) and media from their internet exploration will be presented in a PowerPoint presentation.
- The presentation must include footers with page numbers.
- References will be required on the last slide.
- Shows will be shared with the class.
