Lesson Plan for Ethics in Health Care and the Environment

Students will use the Earth Charter for this lesson.

Upon entering the room the students will be given a colored card which will be used to place them into random groups. Four groups will be organized. Each group will select out of a “hat” which Principle they will be assigned to work on. Students will be given in classroom time to discuss, plan and organize their presentations.

Each group will prepare a presentation on their selected principle. Resources can be used from the internet, references, popular media, films, etc. These will be incorporated into their presentation. Each sub principle must be included in the presentation.

Students must include examples from the United States and at least one other country. At least one positive and one negative example must be included.

Students will lead a classroom discussion as part of the presentation. Engage the class.

Students will be graded on:

Originality of Presentation- creativity classroom teaching strategies, handouts 20%

The depth and understanding of the Principle Presented 20%

Appropriateness of the Examples used, nationally and internationally 20%

Resources used- Minimum of 5 within the last 5 years unless sentinel works 20%

Classroom discussion 20%
